(4 hours) ****

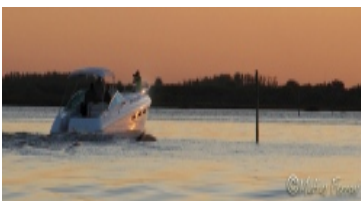
Half day tour around South America's most elegant capital. On the way we will see Plaza de Mayo and the buildings that surround it: Casa Rosada (Government House), Cabildo Old city Hall, the bustling banking and business area. Continuing to the monumental Congress Building and its square. And along 9 de Julio Ave., the widest in the world, to see Colon Theatre, famous Opera House that stages the most important artists and musicians from all over the world. We will also visit San Telmo, la Boca, and its picturesque street "Caminito", Puerto Madero, Palermo Park with Jacaranda and Palo borracho trees which flower in spring and late summer, the polo field and the race track and the historical Recoleta Cemetery with its ornate memorials.



Tigre & Delta Cruise

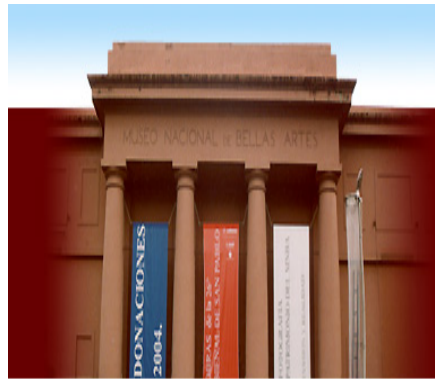
(5 hours) ****

Drive towards the residential area north of Buenos Aires to Olivos. Board the 'Tren de la Costa' (The Coastal Train - modern train on the old suburban railway line which runs along the coast of the Rio de la Plata towards the delta of the river. All stations have been renovated keeping the original buildings built by the British.). Drive to San Isidro where a stop will be arranged. Continue to Tigre, with its gracious homes, weeping willows, open air restaurants and cafes, assorted food vendors, this is the preferred "playground of the porteños". Continue by motor launch for a leisurely cruise along the waterways and islands of the delta. Cruise past turn of the century stone mansions, English cottages, Italian villas, little wooden shacks painted bright colors, rowing and yacht clubs.



Cultural Tour - Museums ****

The cultural heritage in Buenos Aires grows and increases constantly. This tour is a selection of the best art collections of the city. First we go to the institutional center, the Fine Arts National Museum. After that we visit the new and magnificent museum of Latin American modern and contemporary art (MALBA, Costantini Collection). Then we go to the tiny and excellent Xul Solar Museum, that holds the best works of one of the most prestigious Argentinean artists.



Full Day Fiesta Gaucha
