

Iguazu Falls

Iguazú Falls are one of the first attractive natural most imposing of Argentina and along with the Nahuel Huapi National Park in the Patagonia, are one of the most sites frequented by the tourists.

In Guaraní, 'Iguazú' is translated like "Great Waters". They were discovered in 1541 and declared Natural Patrimony of the Humanity by UNESCO in 1984.

It has the most amazing view ever imagined, were the Iguazú River finds its peak and cascades almost 80 meters downwards. The lavish subtropical vegetation and the spray that arises as a consequence of the tremendous downward cascade are often lit by rainbows, adding a spectacular effect.

The Great adventure

The great adventure combines the essence of the Iguazú National Park: Forrest & Falls. Tour begins entering the jungle through the Yacaratiá Trail in 4 x 4 vehicles, with multilingual guides who will let you know about this place and it's natural value.

The 8 km ride ends at Puerto Macuco. From there a 200 meters down by stairs to board the boats for the second part of this trip. Adventure continues with 6 km navigation through the lower Iguazú River and 2 km on rapids up to the Falls area up to the Tres Mosqueteros water jump where you will be able to see Argentine and Brazilian water jumps & the Devil's Throat canyon. Navigation continues between Argentine water jumps up to the most exciting moment: The San Martín water jump, the second larger. Tour continues to the dock in front San Martín Island and ends on the lower walking

Advice:

- We recommend to protect your personal belongings to keep them dry.
- There are 100 meters of stairs that can only be walking passed
- During the tour you will navigate 2km water rapids
- Pregnant women are not permitted on this trip.
- Persons with any heart or back condition have to check before the ride.

Iguazu Forest

It is a unique place for its characteristics and geographical location. It is placed on the Paraná River coast only 7 km from Puerto Iguazú City and 15 km from the Iguazú Falls. Activities offered are:

Canoping: Sliding among several platforms placed in the top of the highest trees, the person slips from a tree to another one through the zip line using a harness. This is the canopy, a new way of enjoying nature, where the adrenaline is the principal protagonist of this activity in the air. The Canopy has a changeable height between 15 and 25 meters with a distance of 800 meters length.

Trekking in the Forest: There is realized by paths inside the jungle, which allow us a recognition of different species of flora (strangler figs, parasite plants, orchids, palm trees) and native fauna. The path has a distance of 900 meters.

Wet Rappelling: Helped permanently by specialized instructors we will do the wet rappelling through a 14 meters waterfall or dry rappelling in a ravine of 20 meters height.

San Carlos de Bariloche

Bariloche was founded in 1902, its name comes from a deformation of Vuriloche (different people or people from the other side) denomination given to the natives of the Eastern part of The Andes Mountains.

Bariloche is located on the coast of Nahuel Huapi Lake, to 770 meters over the sea level. It's one of the most important tourist centers in Argentina. During the winter Cerro Cathedral international skiing center becomes it's mayor attraction. During all year long, Bariloche is the ideal place to practice the mountain climbing, rafting, trekking and fishing; visit it's National Parks, lakes, forest and enjoy its unique panoramic views in the world

Mendoza – Cuyo

Mendoza is a city with tree-lined streets and squares, with 500 Km. of irrigation channels. From Valle de Los Horcones you can admire the south-east face of 6,959 m. high mount Aconcagua, the highest peak in the whole western hemisphere, whose name means "The Stone Sentinel". Further north you come to the statue of the Cristo Redentor (Christ the Redeemer) which indicates the pass Paso de la Cumbre, and the tunnel that leads into Chile. Other places of interest: San Rafael, Río Atuel ; Malargüe and Cueva de las Brujas (Witches' Cave); Llanquanelo lagune and the volcanic region of Payún Matrú; Uspallata and Puente del Inca (Inca Bridge); Tunuyán and Tupungato.

Salta

Salta "The Beautiful". Its name comes from the Aymará word "sagta", which means "the very beautiful one". This city has the best preserved colonial architecture. Its most significant buildings surround the main square: the Cathedral, the Cabildo or Town Council which houses the Museo Histórico del Norte (North Historical Museum); the Casa de Uruburu and the Museo de Bellas Artes (Museum of Fine Arts). The church of San Francisco has one of the tallest church towers in America (53 m) and the Convento de San Bernardo belongs to the Carmelite Order.

Puerto Madryn

This city is located on the clear waters of Golfo Nuevo and is the doorway to Península Valdés. It receives tourists all year round both for fauna and sea-fauna watching and adventure activities. The city becomes a seaside resort in Summer when temperatures are good enough to make the beaches enjoyable. You may be able to go whale-watching from May to December and see sea-lions, and possibly dolphins, from December to March.
